The results of the elections will give preview of the period ahead. Across Europe, traditional parties of the left will be punished as they co-operate with attempts to make workers pay for the crisis and to breathe life back into capitalism.

In France, widespread union resistance including “boss-knapping” is making anti-capitalist and socialist ideas popular. The NPA is at 7% in the polls.

In Britain, the political crisis from the parliamentary expenses is another reason for rejection of the parties that have managed the system.

But we urgently need a broad socialist and working class party to put forward an alternative to organise resistance and give hope. Otherwise the danger is that the right will seize the initiative.

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
